# The Opportunity

## Summary

Future Cities Catapult is seeking a partner to develop a response to the tender likely to be put out by the Greater London Authority to develop an Alpha version of an automated London Development Database.

The Greater London Authority were [successful in bidding for funding from the MHCLG Local Digital Fund<sup>1</sup>](#) for a project that seeks to “prove the concept of automating the flow of planning application data from applicant through the LPA, to the regional authority and out to the public in order to collect more and better information”. As part of this project the GLA state that it will “Look to the market...to develop a suitable ‘alpha’ database to collect and process the data into an analyzable format.

## Bid Concept

Future Cities Catapult wishes to work with a data and software company capable of building an alpha version of a development database, to submit a response to any relevant tender from the GLA. Future Cities Catapult will bring our deep domain expertise in digital planning and is looking for a company with expertise in integrating systems particularly with Idox, Tuscomi and Northgate.

## Partners Capabilities Sought

Future Cities Catapult has in-house expertise in a number of areas relevant to this proposal but is seeking to augment these with a partner with capabilities in the following areas -

- Geospatial Data Science
- Data and software architecture
- Software development
- Systems integration and testing

In 2018, the GLA officially launched the LDD Automation Project which seeks to streamline planning application data from collection through to visualisation and dissemination. Submission of the above information will be considered an expression of your organisation's interest to join the consortia. All registrations of

interest must be submitted by email by **Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2019**. The submissions will be reviewed by Future Cities Catapult based on experience, capability and suitability and you will receive a response on the outcome of your submission by no later than **March 4<sup>th</sup> 2019**.
